The Orchard is a **free** project-based mentoring program for those who want to discover or cultivate a ministry calling. Participants will develop a ministry project of their own design with the support of experienced mentors. The Orchard is a collaboration between Grace Communion International and The Anástasis Center.

- Organization, Time Management, and Project Management

**WHO?** The program is for those who are interested in ministry work but not sure where to start and those engaged in ministry who could benefit from training.

**WHAT?** Each cohort of The Orchard is made up of 5-7 ministry leaders from all over the US.

**HOW?** We use an online platform for all of our meetings so anyone with an internet connection can participate. Each participant gets individual mentoring and gets customized assignments to build content knowledge.

- Program starts with full day (6 hr) intensive on Saturday, March 13, 2021
- Monthly meetings with your mentor: 1 hr each
- Monthly learning sessions with the cohort: 2 hrs each
